EVENT INFORMATION PICKLEBALL RANKING TOURNAMENT

The intention of this tournament is to give competitive players the ability to acknowledge where their standard is compared to players from other clubs within the pickleball community, in doubles play.

Maximum number of players 30.

Players are required to register and pay in advance of the event.

Tournament format


- Each court will have either 4 or 5 players.
 - Players will play a minimum of 3 games with 4 players.
 - Players will play a minimum of 4 games if there are 5 players on a court.
- Each court will be assigned a seeded player (maximum of 6). All other players names will then be drawn out of a hat, for the other 3/4 players on each court.
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- The order of play will be displayed for each court.

Round one

- These matches will ensure players are playing with opponents of a similar standard.
- Following the games, players will be ranked from first to last, using their individual score, depending on the numbers of players.

Round two

- \cdot The players on Court 1 will all be at the top of the rankings list, Court 2 will be in the second section of the ranking, and so on
- Following the games, players will be ranked from first to last, using their individual score, depending on the numbers of players.



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Scoring

- Each game will be scored on court by the players.
 - Games will be scored to 15 if 4 players on a court.
 - Games will be scored up to 11 if 5 players on a court.
- One player per court will be asked to write the result of all the games on the order of play sheet, then tot up all scores including points won and lost for each player.
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ A second player on the court must then check the information is correct, and hand in the sheet.
- The results of the matches will be formulated into a league table, with points being awarded for wins and losses.
